IMPORTANT: All Game Day Hot Shots Division routines are to consist of the following categories and should be performed in this order: Band Cheer/Dance, Crowd Leading Sideline and/Crowd Leading Cheer, and Fight Song. Transitions between categories/elements should not be choreographed but rather display random individual rallying/spiriting, energy, and enthusiasm, i.e. jumps, kicks, punching, waving, etc. No stunts or tumbling are permitted during transitions between categories. Game Day is about performing with energy and enthusiasm on a sideline and/or Game Day situation and should utilize the performance floor to display maximum crowd coverage as would be done at a game.
